**Are You Ready?** 

Epicor wanted to investigate the ability, willingness, and readiness of companies to identify their greenhouse gas emissions.

Do they really know about carbon accounting?

Of those who had heard the term carbon accounting, less than a quarter could accurately describe what carbon accounting means

heard of the term carbon accounting

58% had not

**80%** of companies do not monitor their carbon footprint regularly

We were particularly interested in if and how sustainability strategies are defined and how companies technically capture their emissions.

85% can't tell the level of carbon their company has consumed in each of the last six months

70% believe that they accurately account for less than 25% of their carbon consumption

20% regularly monitor their carbon footprint and most companies use manual processes or spreadsheets to do so

The survey was also designed to clarify the extent to which companies have to meet legal requirements for sustainability and who is responsible internally for CO2 initiatives.

A third doesn't know if their company is under legal obligation to report emissions

While the CEO is the most likely person to be responsible for a company's carbon strategy, 50% don't have any C-level involvement at all
